Golf is a game of HONOUR



There are things you need to remember to play the game FAIRLY.

- HONOUR is about being truthful to yourself and the rules of a sport.
- Golf is a game of HONESTY , ETIQUETTE and MATURITY.
- You are responsible for your own actions and personal conduct on the golf course.

To play the game Fairly



- 1. Be a good sport
- 2. Treat all players as you would like to be treated
- 3. Play for the FUN OF IT, not just to please parents/coaches
- 4. Play by the RULES
- 5. Respect officials and staff
- 6. Cooperate with your coach, team-mates and opponents
- 7. Control your temper
- 8. Always leave the course as you found it
- 9. Dress well (no jeans, football shirts etc)

Keeping you safe



Before beginning you should take note of a few points that will keep you and your friends safe while playing golf.

- Whether you're on the practice area or the course it is important to take a look around you and make sure you can make a swing without hitting anyone or anything with your club.
- Make sure there is no-one standing where you plan to hit your ball.
- If the ball is going near someone shout FORE to warn them. They will duck down and cover their head.
- If it is not your turn, stand quietly and very still by not moving or talking.
- Do not go near or into any of the water on the course to retrieve a ball.
- Members under 10years old MUST be accompanied by an adult member on the golf course
- Do not go out on the golf course by yourself.

Golf for Girls Boys Framework Golf Programmes in Concra Wood



Stages 1-6

Stage 1: Introduce girls/boys to golf in a fun and enjoyable way

Stage 2: To build on the skills learned in Stage One and introduce girls/boys to basic sport specific golf skills
Stage 3: Introduce girls/boys to skills such as goal setting, purposeful practice and obtaining a handicap
Stage 4: Empower girls/boys to take control of their development and test girl's/boy's resilience and reflection skills

Stage 5: To give girls/boys the opportunity to experience golf outside of their club

Stage 6: To facilitate girls/boys to become the best they can be

Sunday Competitions

A schedule of competitions will be put up on the notice board in the next week or so.

- Call into the Pro –shop to enter the competition.
- Be there 10 mins before your Tee-time.
- Bring your golf card
- When finished your game, make sure to sign your card and make sure your marker has signed your card also.
- Enter your score into the computer.

Junior Golfers

To encourage Junior golfers to play more 18 holes of golf they have the option of:

1.Reduced entry of €5 into an 18 hole weekly competition with a junior prize and only eligible to win the junior prize (a minimum of 4 entries needed for a valid competition)

OR

2.Play in the men's or ladies 18 holes weekly competitions, full entry fee and eligible to win any of the prizes on offer except for the junior prize and for girls, 1st prize in the Ladies Major Competitions.

Full handicap required.

Junior members are asked <u>not to go out in a 4ball</u> together when entering the men's or ladies competitions. Please make sure there is a full member with you.
